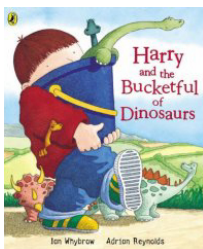
On the reverse of this letter you will find our topic web for next term - *'A bucketful of dinosaurs!'*
